**Guidelines to application for membership**

**1 Completion of the Form**

You must enter your details in the appropriate spaces on the left hand side of the form, and then sign and date the form. Unsigned forms will be declined for membership without further consideration.

**2 Categories of membership**

There are a number of different categories of membership, each of which bears a different subscription and allows the member different rights. These are: Playing, Full, Family & Junior. In addition, there is a Retired category for persons over the state retirement age and Life Membership (non-playing) for a single payment. If you are over 18 years of age and wish to play cricket, then you must apply for 'Playing' membership. Full membership allows participation in the running of the club, with full voting rights. Families may apply jointly (one application form per person) for a single annual subscription. Juniors may play cricket under a Family membership, once they reach adulthood, they will need to convert their membership to Playing if they intend to continue to play cricket or Full if not. You should enter the category you desire next to 'Type of Membership' on the application form. The attention of Parents and Guardians is drawn to section 4 below.

**3 Nominator and Secunder**

In order to be considered for membership, you must be nominated and seconded by two current Full or Playing members. The nominator and seconder should enter their names and sign in the appropriate spaces on the application form.

**4 Note for Parents and Guardians of applicants under the age of 18 years**

Parents and Guardians must sign their consent in the appropriate place on the application form. Please note that by signing this consent you are accepting responsibility for the actions of your child as a member of the club. If your child causes deliberate damage to the property of the club, or is deemed to be acting in a manner inconsistent with membership then you may be held accountable by the Directors of Annfield Plain Cricket Club Ltd. Parents/Guardians who are not already members of the club will automatically become an associate member (non-voting) whilst their child is a junior member of the club. They are also encouraged to become full members of the club.

**5 Consideration of Applications**

Once a properly completed application has been received by the club, it will normally be considered at the next meeting of the Committee. Applicants will then be advised whether their application has been successful or not.
